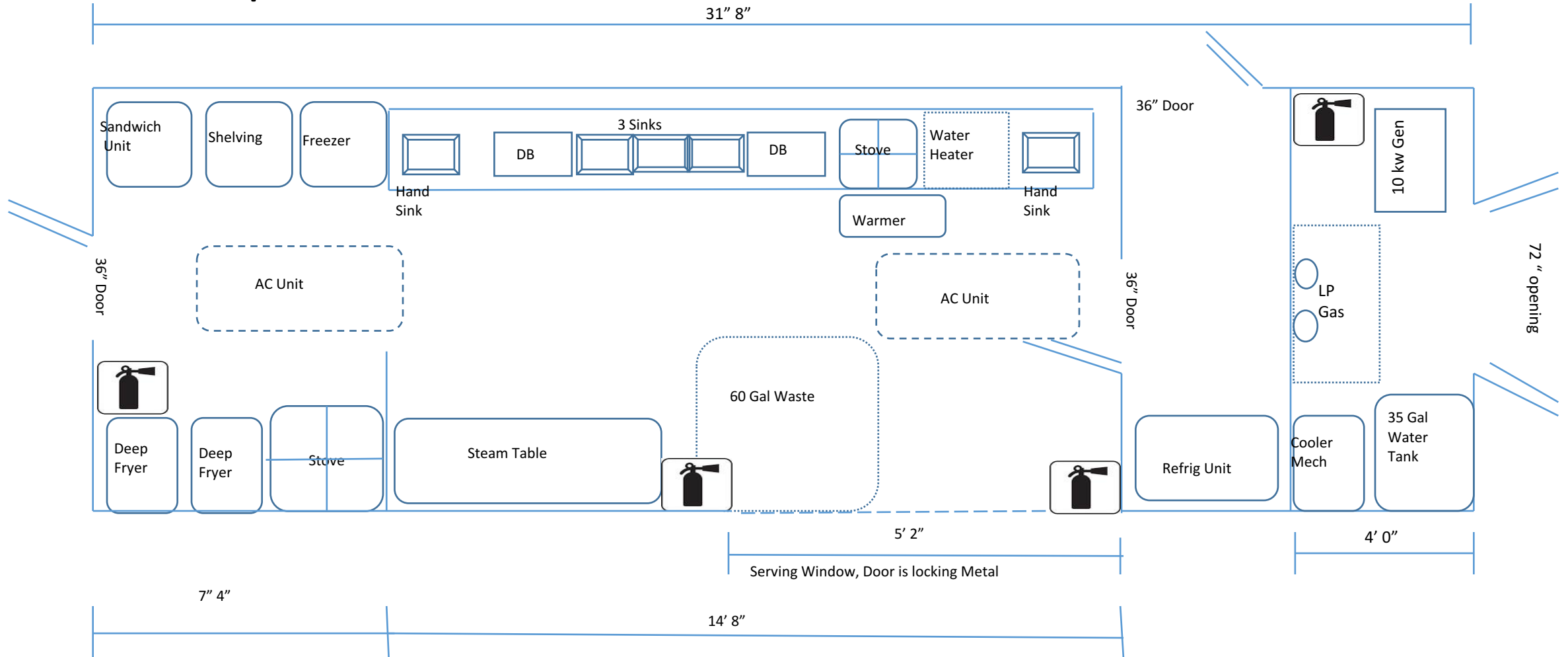
Able to hook up to a generator or 220V electrical power source.

# Safety Standards

- ❖ Trailer has two tow chains that will be connected every time the unit is moved.
- ❖ There will be ground guides used for backing up and close quarters maneuvering.
- ❖ The trailer has two hydraulic legs for stability and leveling of unit.
- ❖ The trailer has a grounding wire for electrical safety.
- ❖ The trailer has a three compartment sink for sanitation of equipment used in cooking.
- ❖ The driver will be responsible for inspecting the truck and trailer prior to any movement of the vehicles.
- ❖ We have a fire suppression unit next to the stove, and 4 fire extinguishers placed throughout the trailer for easy access.
- ❖ All food handlers are certified and trained in food handling safety procedures.
- ❖ Trailer has a first aid kit available.
